#### **Highlights of The Life of King Solomon**

- Solomon was the third and last king of the united kingdom of Israel, following King Saul and King David.
- He was the son of David and Bathsheba, the wife of Uriah whom David had killed to hide his adultery with her.
- Solomon wrote the Song of Solomon, the book of Ecclesiastes, and much of the book of Proverbs.
- Solomon humbly asked God for the wisdom he would need to rule God's people justly. God not only gave him wisdom but also tremendous wealth as well (1 Kings 3:4–15; 10:27).
- Solomon was charged with and completed building the Temple of the Lord per the instructions and provisions of his father, David (1 Kings 6; 1 Chronicles 22).

**Note:** God will equip us to accomplish the tasks He calls us to if we will rely on Him (1 Kings 3; Romans 12:3–8; 2 Peter 1:3), but the spiritual life is a marathon. A good start is not always enough to finish well (1 Kings 3; 11).

#### II Chron 3:1 - 4 (NKJV)

- 1 Now Solomon began to build the house of the Lord at Jerusalem on Mount Moriah, where the Lord had appeared to his father David, at the place that David had prepared on the threshing floor of Ornan the Jebusite.
- 2 And he began to build on the second day of the second month in the fourth year of his reign.
- 3 This is the foundation which Solomon laid for building the house of God: The length was sixty cubits (by cubits according to the former measure) and the width twenty cubits.
- 4 And the vestibule that was in front of the sanctuary was twenty cubits long across the width of the house, and the height was one hundred and twenty. He overlaid the inside with pure gold.



#### II Chron 3:8 – 10, 14 (NKJV)

8 And he made the Most Holy Place. Its length was according to the width of the house, twenty cubits, and its width twenty cubits. He overlaid it with six hundred talents of fine gold.

9 The weight of the nails was fifty shekels of gold; and he overlaid the upper area with gold.

10 In the Most Holy Place he made two cherubim, fashioned by carving, and overlaid them with gold.

14 And he made the veil of blue, purple, crimson, and fine linen, and wove cherubim into it.



### II Chron 3:15 - 17 (NKJV)

15 Also he made in front of the temple two pillars thirty-five cubits high, and the capital that was on the top of each of them was five cubits.

16 He made wreaths of chainwork, as in the inner sanctuary, and put them on top of the pillars; and he made one hundred pomegranates, and put them on the wreaths of chainwork.

17 Then he set up the pillars before the temple, one on the right hand and the other on the left; he called the name of the one on the right hand Jachin, and the name of the one on the left Boaz.

1. What was the purpose(s) for Solomon building the Temple - particularly the Most Holy Place?

#### **The Holy Temple**

- To provide a Dwelling/Resting Place for the Spirit of the Lord.
- A meeting place for Worship/Praise and Prayer for the people of God
- A place to make Confession of sin and give offerings to the Lord.

#### The Holy of Holies

- To House the 10 commandments/ The Law of God.
- To provide a place of intimacy for the High Priest to commune with God.
- To present a blood offering for the Atonement for Sin and come close to the Mercy Seat of God.

#### 2. What did the pillars mean to the Israelites? What does this mean for Christians today?

- The column names Jachin ("He will establish") and Boaz ("Strength is within Him").
- The Pillars were a physical reminder that is God that established Israel is His Strength.
- It is God who choses, saves and strengthens. He does that through His salvation.
- Instead of a Temple dwelling place for God, Jesus is called "Emanuel" – "God is with us".
- Christ's Death tore the veil of temple giving us access to God.
- In Christ we are established as God's people, clothed in His Righteousness and Strength.

Now, therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of <u>the household of God</u>, having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, <u>Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone</u>. (Eph. 2:19-20)



- I Am Empowered The Same Power That Raised Jesus From The Dead Is In Me And Gives the Strength To What I Can't Do On My Own.





#### Highlights of John 3:16 - 17

- Jesus during His earthly ministry met with Nicodemus at night.
- Nicodemus acknowledged Jesus' words and actions as coming from God.
- Jesus challenged Nicodemus that he (we) needed to be "Born Again" of the Spirit in order to be saved and enter the Kingdom of God.
- After showing how Moses lifting up the Serpent to save the Jews in the OT (Num 21:9) was a reference to Himself, Jesus proclaimed this wonderful promise of the Gospel.

**Note:** Nicodemus is described in John 19:38 as a disciple of Jesus, albeit a secret one because he was afraid of the Jews. Nicodemus also assisted Joseph of Arimathea in Jesus' burial.

#### 4. What words or phrases resonate most with you? Why?


- <u>God so loved</u> The fact that God so loves <u>me</u> 1<sup>st</sup> I am grateful, valuable and I love me (How can I not love <u>me</u> whom <u>God loves</u>).
- He Gave His Only Son God's Love motivated Him to give me his very best – His Son. I can trust Him to give me whatever else I need.
- <u>Shall Not Perish</u> O what a comfort 1<sup>st</sup> for those loved ones (Dad, Mom, Wife, Friends...) but most for me – <u>that</u> death is not final. PTL!!!
- <u>Everlasting Life</u> O, what a joy and peace I have because I life everlasting. I have Joy for Today because my eternal future is secure.





#### 4. What words or phrases resonate most with you? Why?

- God did not send His Son into the world to condemn Even though I am truly guilty of sin In Christ, God does not condemn me (He will convict and correct but never condemn Rom 8:1).
- But that the world through Him might be saved —
   Through Jesus: His suffering, His blood, His death on the Cross and His Resurrection is what saves me.
   This salvation is available for/to the whole world.



## OVERCOMER

5. Compare Ephesians 3:16 – 19 with John 3:16. Describe the dimensions of God's Love for you.

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life." (John 3:16)

[That you] ...may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height— 19 to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; (Eph. 3:18 – 19a)

- For God so loved the world The <u>Width</u> of God's Love.
- He gave His only begotten Son The <u>Depth</u> of God's Love.
- Whoever believes in Him should not perish The Height of God's Love.
- But have everlasting life The <u>Length</u> of God's Love.





#### Ephesians 2:1 – 5 (NKJV)

1 And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins,

2 in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience,

3 among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others.

4 But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us,

5 even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),



## Ephesians 2:6 - 10 (NKJV)

6 and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,

7 that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

8 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God,


9 not of works, lest anyone should boast.

10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

#### 6. According to this passage, how does God save people?

- He Made [Us] Alive, Who Were Dead In Trespasses And Sins -We are regenerated by His Spirit – not from what we do.
- But God, Who Is Rich In Mercy His Mercy Not giving us what our sins deserve (Death, Eternal Separation and Punishment from God.
- His Great Love With Which He Loved Us He is the One loved us first – even while we were disobedient to Him (I John 4:19).
- By Grace Through Faith In Jesus Christ His Grace giving us a Salvation that we don't deserve. All because of the Work of Christ.
- By A Free Gift All His Doing A Precious Invaluable gift -That is given without merit.

#### Eph. 2:5 - 10

Made Us Sit Together In The Heavenly Places In **Christ Jesus.** 

That In The Ages To Come He Might Show The **Exceeding Riches Of His Grace In His Kindness Toward** Us In Christ Jesus.

It Is The Gift Of God, Not Of Works, Lest Anyone **Should Boast.** 

For We Are His Workmanship, Created In Christ Jesus For Good Works, Which God Prepared Beforehand That We Should Walk In Them.

#### **Reasons God Saves**

For Unity With Christ And With Each Other (To Worship, Serve, Proclaim, Thanksgiving Pray, Enjoy God's Blessings - Together).

To Place Us At His Heavenly Table With Him And His Son Jesus Christ.

To Have A People That He Can Enjoy And Bless And Display His Glorious Grace For The Praise Of His Glory.

That Everyone Will Know That Salvation Only Comes From The Lord And Is Free To All.

To Do The Work Of The Lord - That He Has Created And Predetermined For Us To Do (We Are Saved For His Purpose - Not Our Own).
